**Visitors can climb this historic landmark through a looped, single-track trail. From these trails, hikers can reach the base of “The Rock” and are afforded panoramic views of Downtown Castle Rock, the Interstate 25 corridor, Pikes Peak and the Front Range.**

Please use caution when navigating the uneven terrain of this relatively short but steep climb. There is a 370-foot elevation difference from bottom to top (6,220 feet to 6,590 feet).

The picnic pavilion at Rock Park is available for rental. For information, call 720-733-2260.

The main trailhead parking lot, with a portable restroom, is located on Front Street. Additional parking is available at Castle North Park. On-street parking is allowed on Canyon and Sunset drives.

### Rock Park Directions

#### Directions from I-25:

1. Take the Wolfensberger Rd/Wilcox St exit, Exit 182.
2. Turn east at the ramp and follow Wilcox St. for 0.4 miles.
3. Turn left at 5<sup>th</sup> St. and follow for 375 feet.
4. Turn left at Perry St. and follow for 0.5 miles.  
Perry St. turns into Front Street.
5. Rock Park will be on your right.
